Dear Senator Coburn,

I heard your very informative comments on the PBS program NOW, and thought you might find interesting a CD with some energy information I've accumulated.

The information includes documentation, and more than 100 other documents, for the following: 77 years ago the President of General Motors predicted 80-mpg by 1939; 70 years ago Ford Motor Co. tested a 170-mpg Pogue carburetor; 33 years ago Shell Oil Co demonstrated a 376-mpg automobile; 29 years ago a 100-mpg Ford V-8 was demonstrated; 23 years ago Peugeot advertised a 72-mpg @ 56-mph Diesel. 4 years ago an English newspaper article announced a 104-mpg Toyota Diesel and 94-mpg VW/Audi Diesels. Commercial fuel cell vehicles have been available in Europe for years. Many U.S. Patents exist for devices that separate the elements of water for use as fuel, one patent was granted 107 years ago.

Attached is a document, from a book written by Shell Oil staff, confirming the comments of the General Motors president.

I hope the information will be useful to you.

My Virginia members of congress were informed of similar information years ago.
